CLASS RULES

Showmanship - Showman to demonstrate ability to lead, turn and have his/her horse perform, as the judge directs. To be judged 50% for handling of the horse, 25% for grooming of the horse, and 25% for neatness of the handler.

Equitation - Riders to be judged on hands, seat and performance of horse. Horses should be able to perform at a walk, trot/jog, canter/lope, take the correct lead, back readily and perform any tests the judge may ask for.

Pleasure - Horses to be judged on manners and performance. Should be able to perform skills listed for equitation classes.

Walk - Trot - Designed for beginners. Same as equitation classes, omitting the canter/lope. No cross entry with other equitation classes.

Gaming Classes - Rules for gaming classes will be announced at the show. Barrels and poles to be run over standard course (space permitting). Key hole course shall be run through two sets of two poles - not a chalk key hole. **Helmets required in Games.**

Ellensburg Rodeo Posse and Kittitas County Fair Board Youth Horse Show

GENERAL RULES

1. **No stallions** allowed to be shown by exhibitors.
2. Every exhibitor entered in the show will be assigned a number which should be plainly visible in all classes.
3. If there are less than three (3) entries in any class, it may be combined with the next older group. However, age groups to be judged separately.
4. Riders shall be appropriately attired.
Western Classes: Riders should be attired in western clothes - long sleeve shirt, hat and western boots. **Helmets may be worn in the Western classes.** Chaps, lariat, and hobbles are optional. Western bit is required.
English Classes: Riders should be attired in either hunt seat or saddle seat attire.
5. No running martingales in English Classes.
6. Age Classes: Classes follow the 4-H age groupings.
Junior: Through fifth grade.
Intermediate: Sixth through eighth grade
Senior: Ninth through twelfth grade
Exception: This show is open to youth who are under the age of eight (8) years old. Anyone who is under eight years old will be included in the Junior Classes. Age class is determined by the school year just completed.
7. Please ask for a gate hold, if one is needed, at least one class in advance.
8. Ribbons to six (6) places and a \$10.00 first place gift certificate will be awarded for each class.
9. Trophies are awarded for the high point exhibitor in each age category. Points are awarded in the following classes:
English Equitation
Western Equitation
Gaming
Overall high point trophies are also awarded in each category. Ride-offs will be announced at the July show. You must ride in both shows to be considered for these awards.
10. Trophies for each age class will be awarded at the July show. Overall high point trophies will be awarded at the Posse Sunday Night Show during the Kittitas County Fair.
